

BROTHER COL. THOMAS SANDERSON

Bro. Thomas Sanderson was initiated into Leamington lodge no.290 in 1922. In December, 1934, after returning to London he affiliated with Ashlar. His sponsors at that time were Wor. Bro. Jack Meriam and Wor. Bro. Wm. Tanton.

His real contribution to Masonry has been in the Ancient and Accepted Rite. He is a member of the London Lodge of Perfection. He served as the Most Wise Sovereign of the London Sovereign Chapter of Rose Croix in 1955. In 1959 he was coroneted an honorary inspector general thirty third degree at Supreme Council held that year in London.

At the formation of Oakridge Lodge no. 708 he was a charter member and has served as Chaplain since its inception.

Col. Sanderson has had a very distinguished military career in both the active and reserve armies. For many years he operated a very successful greenhouse business on Western Road near the University of Western Ontario.
